Responsibilities:

Provide general and emergency respiratory therapy procedures to patients as directed by physicians and protocols. Procedures include, but are not limited to:

- Respiratory assessment

- Lung expansion therapy
- Intubation
- CPR
- Bronchoscopy assistance
- Arterial line placement
- Arterial sampling
- ABG analysis and interpretation

Demonstrate the ability to recognize change in the patient's condition, make independent judgments, and modify the care as necessary according to departmental standards and approved physician protocols. Routinely make rounds with physicians in critical care units. Act as preceptor, actively support and constructively contribute to the development of new and existing staff members.

Requirements:

RRT credential is required. Valid Idaho Respiratory Care Practitioner license is required. Healthcare provider BLS certification required. ACLS certification required or obtained within six months of hire. Current PALS or NRP certification preferred. Must possess good organization skill and English language communication skill. Ability to function independently and proficiently in all patient care areas. Intermediate computer skills with an emphasis on MS Office applications.
